#### INTRO:

# I. WE ARE PRAYING TO AN EVER-PRESENT, LIVING GOD.

- A. Every prayer in the Bible is offered to a personal God.
- B. Heb. 11:6; Heb. 13:5; Matt. 28:20; Psalm 139:1-17

#### II. WE NEED HIM.

- A. Prayer assumes the weakness of man and the unlimited strength of God.
- B. "When we fail to pray, we plan to fail."
- C. John 15:5

## III. GOD HEARS PRAYER.

- A. As we pray we move up to God and he moves down to us.
- B. James 4:8; 1 Pet. 3:12; 1 Pet. 5:6, 7; 1 John 5:14

## IV. GOD ANSWERS PRAYER.

- A. He is here! He listens! He has power! He will answer!
- B. John 15:7, 16; John 16:23; 1 John 5:15
- C. Notice that God answers only those who believe in Christ. 1 John 5:13

- 2. In order to have my prayers answered I must:
  - a. Repent. Luke 13:3
  - b. Confess Christ. Rom. 10:10
  - c. Be baptized. Acts 22:16
