INTRO:

- 1. Third world countries do not have near the standard of living enjoyed in this country.
- 2. But in some ways they have what we have left behind.
 - a. They seem to laugh more than we do. **Prov. 17:22**
 - b. They have time for bible class and preaching. 1 Cor. 1:18
 - c. They have large families with plenty of children. **Psalm 127:3-5**
 - d. They enjoy the simple pleasures that we gave up years ago and they find time to stop and smell the roses.

WHO HAS THE GOOD LIFE?

- 1. They worry about getting enough vitamins in their diet; we worry about getting too much cholesterol and fat.
- 2. Their clothes are worn out because they wash them on a rock; ours are thrown out because they are last year's fashion.

- 3. They worry about chasing rats away; we worry about winning the rat race. Mark 6:31
- 4. They live in huts because they cannot afford better houses; we live in houses we cannot afford. Luke 12:15
- 5. They are poor and humble; we are rich and proud. Rev. 3:17
- 6. They die at forty with disease and poor medicine; we die at fifty with heart attacks and lung cancer. 1 Cor. 6:19, 20
- 7. Their women rarely wear pants in public; ours wear hardly anything at all. 1 Tim. 2:9
- 8. They bathe nearly naked in a river for lack of indoor plumbing; we have plumbing and sunbathe nearly naked.
- 9. They are not bothered by hypertension and lung cancer; we have wiped out malaria and typhoid.
