INTRO:

- 1. The Lord was prepared to do his work, but first man had to do his part.
- 2. God does not do for me what I can and should do for myself.
- 3. Even though the stone concealed a stinking and fearful sight, it had to be removed to correct the situation.
- 4. We must remove our "stones of stumbling" in:

I. RELATIONSHIPS.

A. The problems must be addressed.

- 1. It is a hindrance to our worship. Matt. 5:23, 24; 1 Cor. 10:16, 17
- 2. It is a hindrance to unity. Psalm 133:1; 1 Cor. 1:10; Col. 2:1, 2
- 3. It is a hindrance to growth. Matt. 12:25; Gal. 5:14, 15
- B. Christ has the answer. Matt. 18:15-17; 22:37-39

II. SERVICE.

- A. We must take away the fear. Isa. 51:12, 13; Phil. 1:27, 28
 - 1. Fear is contagious. Deut. 20:8
 - 2. Fear is not from God. 2 Tim. 1:7
- B. We must take away the indifference. Matt. 22:37; Rom. 9:3

CONC:

- 1. Jesus raised Lazarus after the barrier was removed. He will do the same for us today. Rom. 6:3, 4
- 2. Take away the stone and obey him today!
- 3. Remove the barriers and get right with one another.
- 4. Roll away the stone that covers your talents and be involved in serving God.
