JESUS DONATED BLOOD FOR YOU

Rev. 5:9, 10

- I. **OUR PINT IS A DONATION; JESUS' GIFT WAS A SACRIFICE.**
- II. **OUR DONATION IS IN COMFORTABLE STERILE CONDITIONS.**
- III. **OUR DONATION IS QUICK AND RELATIVELY EASY; HIS WAS DRAWN OUT AND PAINFUL.**
- IV. **OUR PINT WILL BE EXPENSIVE TO THE RECIPIENT; CHRIST'S BLOOD IS FREE TO ALL.**
 - A. Salvation is a free gift. **Rom. 6:23; John 4:10; Rom. 5:15-18**
 - B. We are justified freely. **Rom. 3:24**
 - C. The water of life is freely given. **Rev. 22:17**
 - D. The Spirit tells us of the things that have been freely given to us by God. **1 Cor. 2:12**
 - E. We surely all agree: **thanks be to God for His indescribable gift! 2 Cor. 9:15**
- V. **OUR DONATION GOES OUT OF DATE AFTER 42 DAYS; CHRIST'S BLOOD IS ETERNALLY FRESH.**
 - A. Christ's blood is as powerful today as it was the day it was given.
 - B. Jesus only gave once for all. **Heb. 10:12**
- VI. **OUR BLOOD MAY BE REJECTED DUE TO SOME CORRUPTION; JESUS' BLOOD IS PURE AND SINLESS.**
 - A. About 37% of the U.S. population is eligible to give blood (only 10% do).
 - B. Peter made 4 references to the purity of Christ and his gospel in one passage. **1 Pet. 1:18-23**
- VII. **ONE PINT OF MY BLOOD CAN SAVE UP TO THREE LIVES; ONE DROP OF THE BLOOD OF JESUS CAN SAVE THE WORLD.**
 - A. The top reason for giving blood is to help others. Jesus came for that very reason. **Luke 19:10**
 - B. The precious nature of blood is made clear in both testaments.
 - C. The blood of Jesus is by far the most precious. **Eph. 1:7; 1 John 1:7**
